Overview

Divine Healing Ministries of GA (DHMGA) is a 501c3 nonprofit organization focused on helping the underserved and uninsured population in Georgia. There is a huge population of underserved and homeless people in the US. More than 300,000 uninsured Georgians' income is too low for obtaining Marketplace Healthcare subsidies or too high to obtain Medicaid. Georgia has 148 medically underserved areas or populations, which means that only 11 of Georgia's 159 counties do not have one or the other. We don't have enough medical professionals to serve the population. As of January 2018, Georgia had an estimated 9,499 experiencing homelessness on any given day, as reported by Continuums of Care to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).


Goals

1. To reduce health disparities in underserved and rural areas.
2. To improve the health equity of lives by providing the basic resources of life.

Specifications

God's Love Project

Divine Healing Ministries of Georgia God's Love Project will provide chiropractic services, health screenings, and mental health counseling for a low cost along with case management to ensure patients are connected with other local resources for continuity of care. Blood work will be conducted to check for blood sugar levels. Blood pressure levels will be checked for hypertension. More extensive lab work will be processed through Quest Diagnostic Labs for an additional fee. Our target is to reach at least 500 people each year. Our goal is to help as many people as we can. The expense of the initial visit is \$200 (includes \$35 for office visit, \$15 for medical supplies, and \$149 for Basic Health Profile blood test) to obtain a baseline to help identify health conditions. Many patients might not be able to afford it so we are relying on donations to help cover the costs.



To ensure homeless people have shelter from the elements, we offer tents and sleeping bags for transient traveling. It helps provide portable shelter until indoors transitional living space is available. The cost: \$200

Milestones

I. Health Screenings

Health screenings will begin in January 2020. Our initial screening will be held at 3651 Canton RD Suite 203 Marietta, GA 30066 with one of our partners, Fortified City Christian Church. They will be conducted throughout the region from Albany, GA to Rome, GA.

II. Bible Training Classes

Bible training classes began in September 2019. They are held monthly on the first Saturdays of each month excluding the months of December and July. The classes are conducted from 10 am to 1pm at a predetermined location. The cost is \$25 per class to help cover the cost of the event.
